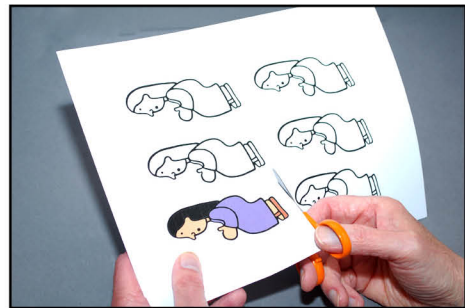


You will need:

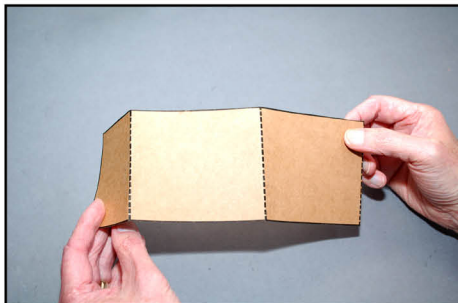
- template 1 printed onto white card
- template 2 and 3 printed onto brown card
- template 4 printed onto coloured card
- template 5 printed onto yellow card
- scissors
- double-sided tape
- coloured pencils or felt tips



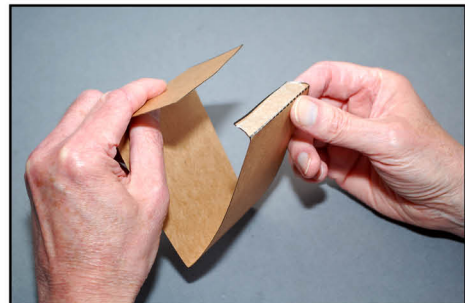
Step 1: colour in template 1



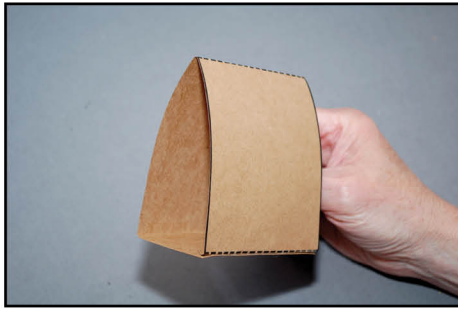
Step 2: cut out templates



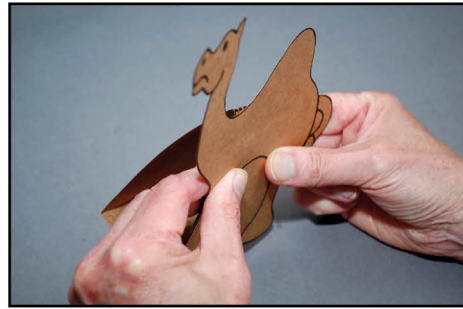
Step 3: fold template 2 along dotted lines



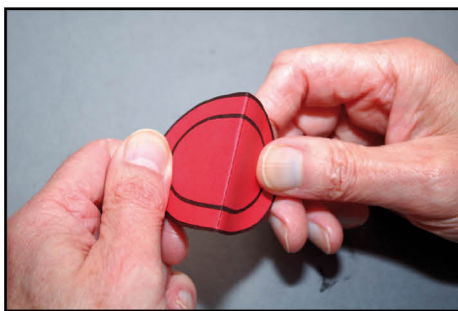
Step 4: fold it round till the tab meets the other side



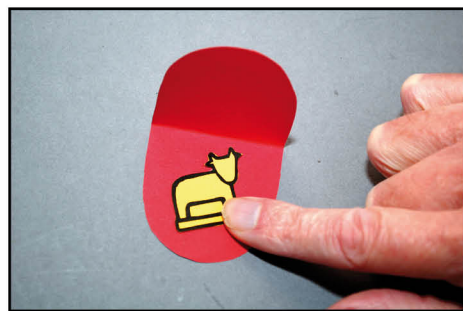
Step 5: stick the tab to make a stand



Step 6: stick the camel to the side of it



Step 7: fold template 4 along dotted line



Step 8: stick template 5 piece inside



Step 9: stick one side of camel sack to the camel



Step 10: stick Rachel on top of the camel sack.



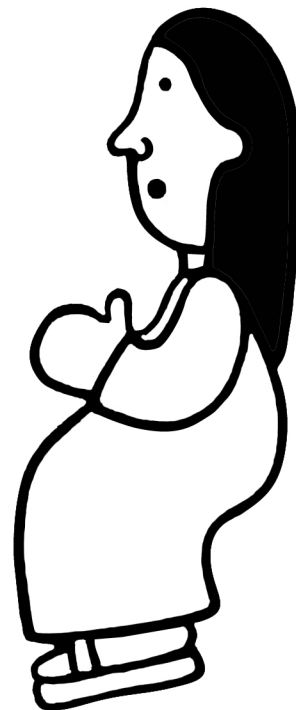
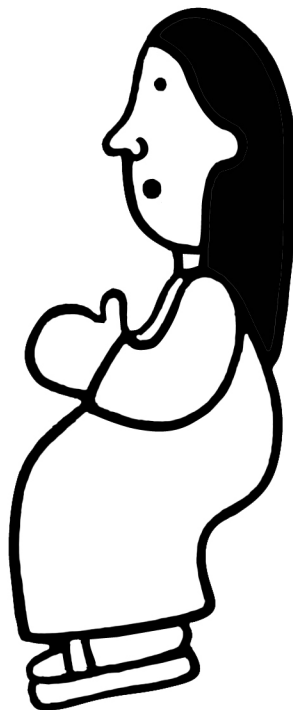
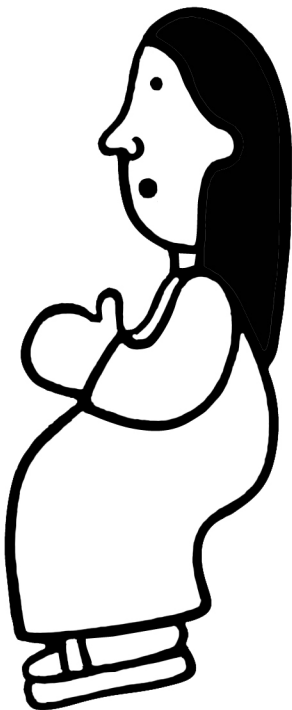
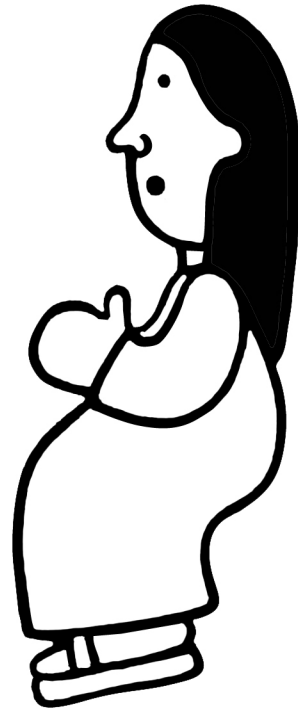
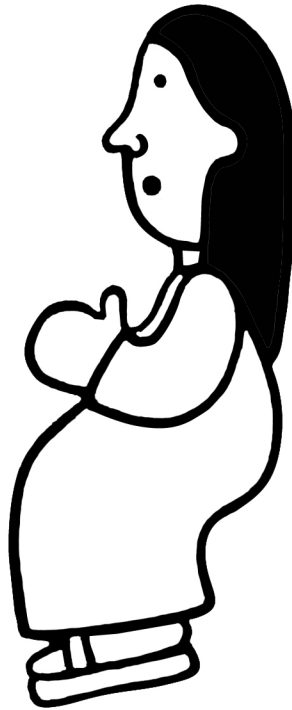
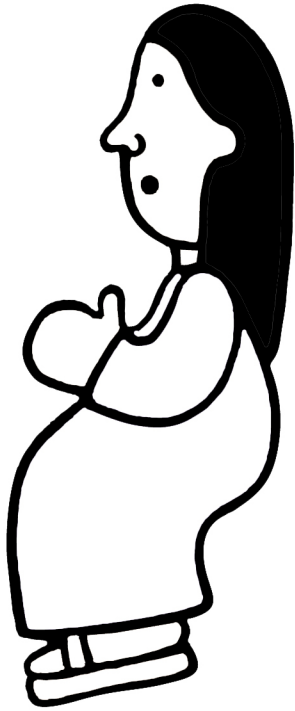
For a shorter session:

use pre-coloured template 1

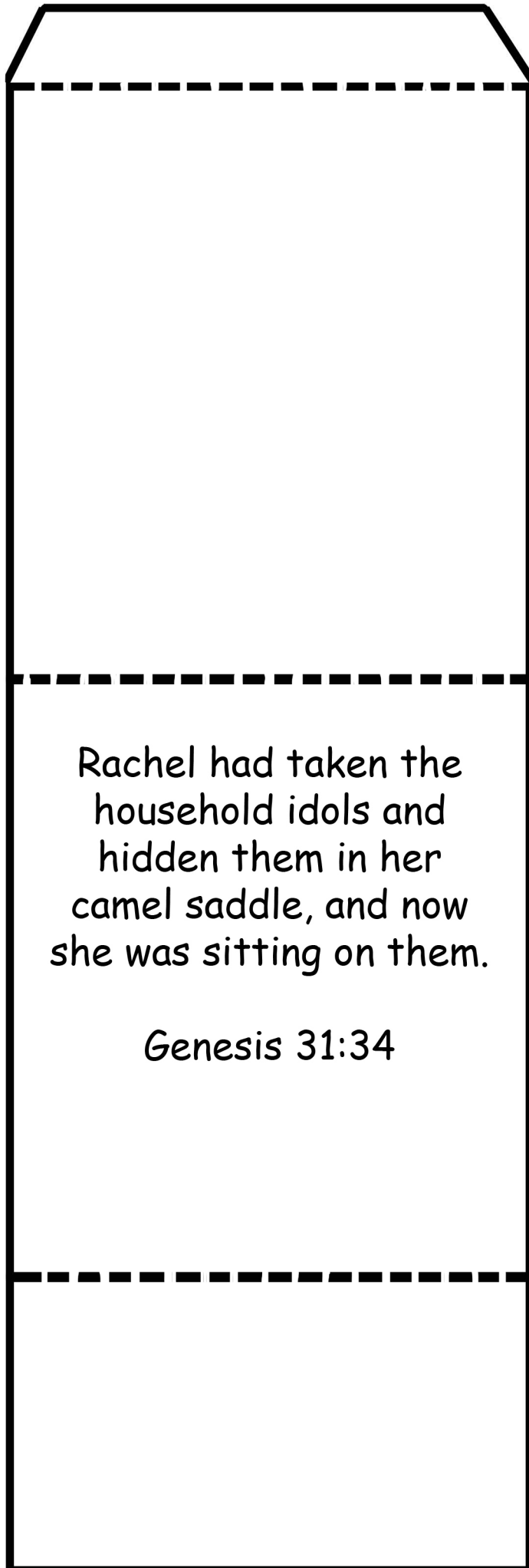


Rachel did not completely trust God. She still wanted to keep an idol.
